

SWIMMING WITH YOUR DOG What You Should Know

We want you and your dog to have fun in the pool and stay safe. Here are a few things you must be familiar with before you engage in any pool-based activity.

- Please avoid your dog inhaling the water as this can lead to complications. Should you suspect this has happened please inform the staff immediately.
- Do not allow your dog to drink excessively as this can be very harmful to your dog.
- Do allow your dog to rest a minute after each five minutes of activity.
- Please discourage your dog from barking.
- It is your responsibility to inform the staff of any special needs you may have.
- You must be medically fit and well to undertake the pool-based activity with your dog.
- All our staff are trained in human first aid and canine first aid.
- Please make sure we have your current emergency contact details on file.
- Staff are on hand to supervise should you need us.
- Lastly and most importantly have FUN!
